## **First Baptist Church parsonage update—August 29, 2016**

The custodial committee wanted the members of our church to have an update on what is happening after the water damage to the parsonage basement. I will try and bring everyone up to speed on what has taken place and what will hopefully take place in the near future.

Since our business meeting in July, the parsonage has under-went an air quality test to make sure the mold was taken care of and parsonage would be ready for anyone to move into. This included: removing mold for any and all wood in the basement, total wipe down of basement and upstairs and cleaning of all duct work. After this was completed, an extensive series of test were run to determine if the mold had been taken care of. This test was done on Friday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, the week after our business meeting. I was notified on August 2<sup>nd</sup> that the test results had come back. Results were not acceptable and further treatment and another test would be required. A meeting was set up for Friday, August 12 to meet with our insurance adjustor, Servpro and Klingler & Associates to put a plan together to get the air quality to acceptable levels. It was determined that Servpro would do further cleaning (at their expense) and we would re-test after the second round of cleaning was accomplished. That test is scheduled for Monday, Aug 29<sup>th</sup>. Hopefully it will pass this time.

When the parsonage is considered to be ready for habitation, the second phase will start to take place. This should include an estimate of damages that will include any repairs in basement that can be traced to the water damage and floor covering in the upstairs rooms that were carpeted. While we have estimates on floor covering for the carpeted rooms, we cannot proceed until we have the “go ahead” from our adjustor and our insurance company, Church Mutual. After we get the go ahead, flooring will have to be ordered, installed and final cleaning of the parsonage. At this time, flooring for the kitchens and bathrooms would be at the churches expense. If it is decided to do both, additional time and money will be needed from church as neither of these will be part of the damage claim.

Hopefully this explains where we are at and what we are trying to accomplish. The committee knows that time is running short to get this all put together before our new pastor arrives. We are doing what we can, but have to work within the parameters laid out by our adjustor and Church Mutual.

On another note: We are in need of a few volunteers to assist in painting the pastor’s office before he arrives. PLEASE let me know if anyone is interested is assisting.

## **August 30, 2016**

As of this morning, I have not heard anything on the test’s that were performed yesterday. I do not foresee getting anything back until next week. Hopefully, I will be surprised. Garage door has been ordered and will be installed. Tom Bock has taken care of this along with ordering sliding glass patio door. French doors were discussed but due to small dining room, sliding doors were determined to be the best. Part of the custodial committee took a hard look at the kitchen and bathroom flooring. It was determined that the flooring in these units had a lot of wear left and are serviceable. If remodeling is considered at a later date, these rooms could come into play. Flooring for the three rooms where carpet was removed has been selected. A very nice, middle of the road laminate is what we suggest. As I have said before, we cannot order the flooring until a settlement number has been arrived at for physical damage to the parsonage. Again, hopefully this process will begin as soon as air quality tests are deemed satisfactory.
