REDEEMING REFUGEES - Ministering to Sudanese
Refugees in Uganda results in new believers, clarity in
the gospel, and economic opportunities. Mission Study of Uganda,
one refugee feeling from war in a neighboring country turned
away from Islam and came to faith in Christ. Now he is an
evangelist and pastor to his people and has helped missionaries
make crucial gospel connections in Uganda's vast refugee
settlements. These missionaries minister to and local Ugandans by
distributing food periodically, providing medical aid, completing
building projects, repairing wells, helping them heal from trauma,
and above all, teaching the gospel.

They testify, "It is just so incredible that Jesus accomplished salvation for us and then calls us to be a part of the gospel work. He doesn't just drop that task in our laps but equips us with His Spirit to do the work He is calling us to do. It's a crucial reminder for all who follow Christ."
