Main Point: Moses ran into the wilderness, met God and spent nearly all of his latter life there for God's purposes. (a second home)

I. DEFINING LEGACY THROUGH ACTION AND CONVICTION (1-10)

II. DEFINING LEGACY THROUGH HIS LIFE'S THEME (11-14)

1. You have witnessed what God has done.
2. God wants to establish/stabilize you.
3. There will be standards (big picture and small)
4. The clear choice is in front of you/don't complicate this!
5. You must make the right decisions (life and death)
6. There will always be protection and accountability

III. DEFINING LEGACY THROUGH THE HUMAN-DIVINE RELATIONSHIP (15-20)

He wanted this relationship for everyone! He know how much God cared.

1. He desired to see God's glory
2. He trusted God's Words
3. He respected God's justice
4. He loved God's people and interceded for them
5. He saw God's vision
6. He lived God's story
7. He knew God's voice
