Main Point: Moses ran into the wilderness, met God and spent nearly all his latter life there for God's purposes. (a second home)

1. God has shown Himself and we are accountable for this (2)
2. We've been through a great deal of sorrow (3-8)
3. Still, God wants to establish/stabilize you (9-13)

III. THE OFFER OF LEGACY IS YOURS FOR THE TAKING (Deut. 29:29-30-30:14)

1. Seek and you shall find (Jesus)
2. The Lord is seeking you as well (lost sheep)
3. God will change you within to know Him (new birth)
4. God will clear the way for you (make straight the way in the wilderness)
5. The biggest "little word" in the Bible . . .
6. God wants you to find Him/this life/legacy
