HE IS IN THE WILDERNESS: How God's Nearness Changes Us (Psalm 34)

Main Point: Christians should live and promote consistent communion with God by heeding the call to seek, know, and fear Him.

I. GOD OVERWHELMS US WITH HIS PRESENCE (1-3)

- It should be with both voice and soul (Surrender)
- It should be at all times (Discipline)
- The humble see and it changes them (Witness)
- It should be a communal act (Unified Service)

Invitation: "O magnify the Lord with me!"

II. GOD DISMISSES FEAR WITH HIS PRESENCE (4-8)

- He sought Him and found Him! (Jer. 29:11-13)
- His fears were overwhelmed by God and he was protected

Invitation: "O taste and see that the Lord is good!"

I PETER 2:2-3

Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation, now that you have tasted that the Lord is good.

III. GOD'S PRESENCE RESULTS IN HEALTHY FEAR (9-14)

Invitation: "O fear the Lord!"

1. No want for those who fear (Ps. 23:1)
2. It must be taught
3. It changes our behavior
