The Maturity that Comes with the Journey Praying at a Deeper Level (Psalm 51)

Main Point: *Our prayers must take our sins seriously if it is to take God's holiness seriously, coming through growth and maturity in Him.*

I. ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR SIN (1-4)

History: David's sin with Bathsheba

- He should have been in battle
- He broke all 10 Commandments
- He tried to cover it up
- He was rebuked by the prophet
- He lost his child
- This sin contributes to greater losses as well

Key Point: *David asks for God to be Himself, "according to your . . .", "against you only . . .", and "you are justified . . .".*

II. ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR SINFUL NATURE (5)

III. ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR SIN'S CONSEQUENCES (6-9)

1. I am a liar
2. I am foolish
3. I am dirty
4. I am sorrowful
5. I am broken
6. I am to be shunned

IV. ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR NEED FOR FORGIVENESS (10-17)

Rules to confession:

1. It is our fault alone
2. God alone can cleanse us, restore us
3. We are to tell others about our experience of God's mercy
4. We must realize what God desires (brokenness, contriteness, honesty)
