The Necessity of Servants Acts 6

Main Point: God provides for our every need including servants who will keep the work of the Kingdom moving forward in and out of season.

- I. WHEN THE CHURCH IS GROWING, CHALLENGES WILL COME (1-2)
 - a. Legitimate concern (unjust, division-causing, racial, social, etc.)
 - b. Proverbs 6:6
 - c. The expectation of unity
 - d. The need to carry the mission forward without delay

- II. GOD HAS SOLUTIONS FOR CRITICAL ISSUES AND GIVES WISDOM IN SUCH CIRCUMSTANCES (3-4)
 - a. You appoint men to take care of these issues
 - b. We will keep the main thing the main thing

- III. UNITY IS BROUGHT ABOUT THROUGH STRUGGLE (5-7)
 - a. Everyone works toward a solution (not gossip, not army-building, not licking our wounds)
 - b. Everyone has a “stake” in progress
 - c. Divisions become less important than the unifying mission
 - d. God honors the decision/priorities established
