**Main Point:** God uses a diverse group of women to fulfill His will in the lives of kids.

### I. **JAMES AND JOHN'S MOTHER (Matthew 20:20-28)**

- Wanted the best for her sons
- Saw their great potential (beyond their flaws)
- Raised them to recognize God's presence
- Did not share concern for how others perceived her work on their behalf

### II. **THE MOTHER WHO HELPED FEED THE MASSES**

- Just doing "her job"
- Not expecting anything monumental or noteworthy
- Without a name or a face
- Her simple act of care was used mightily and still spoken of today

### III. **MARY, THE MOTHER OF JESUS**

- Obedient to God's call on her son's life
- Willing to adjust as God revealed more of His will
- Never left Him along in His darkest hour

### IV. **THE ONE WHO IS HARD TO FIND (Proverbs 31)**
